Duties as a volunteer will include helping individual campers with personal needs, dorm supervision at night, working with outdoor education centre staff during program planning and delivery, being a "buddy" for the week to one or more unaccompanied campers.

Who should apply?

Blind Beginnings is looking for volunteers with a background in recreational therapy or a related field (i.e. recreation therapy, occupational therapy, etc.).

Experience working with blind and visually impaired youth is an asset, though not necessary. Training will be provided by Blind Beginnings prior to the Camp.

Camp Dates: July 21 - July 25 2023

A criminal record check and attendance at our Blindness 101 Orientation session will be required prior to participating in this program.
