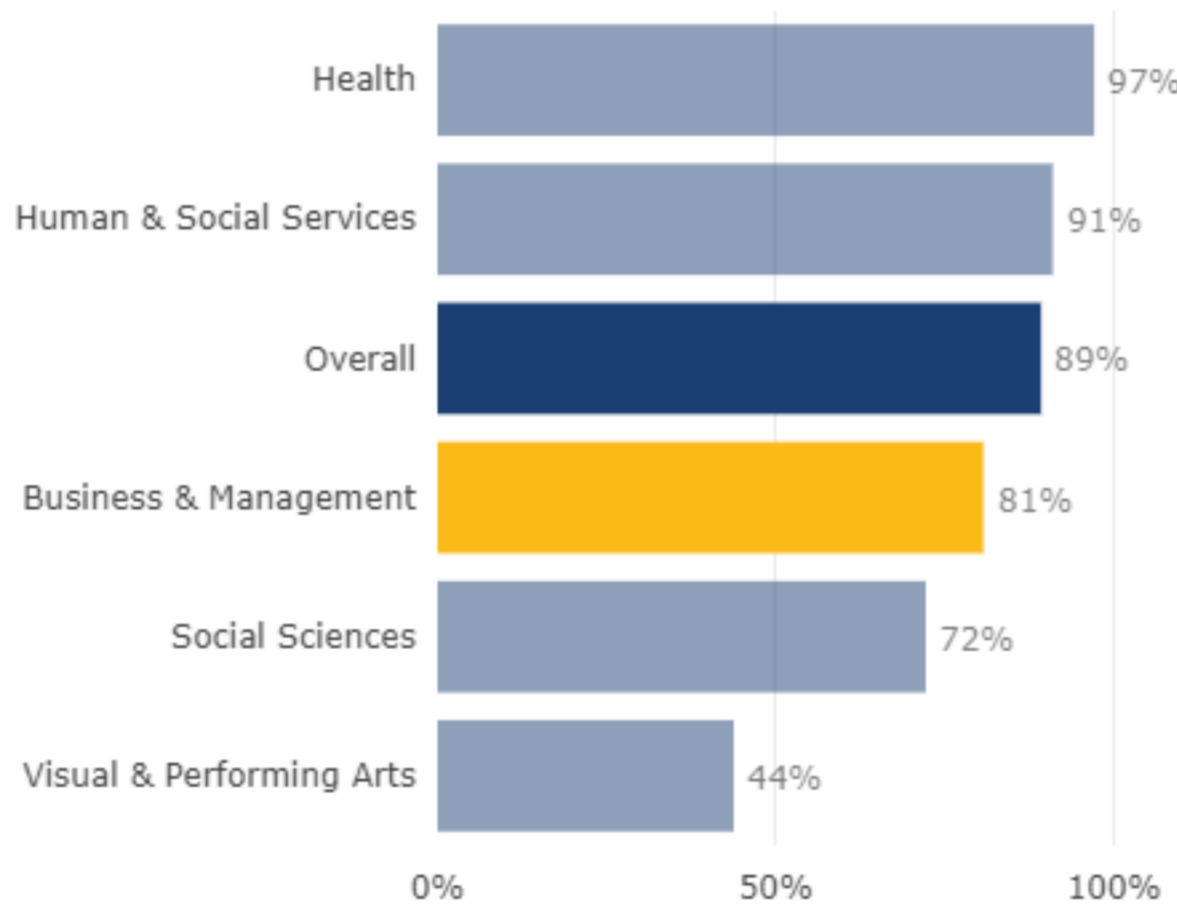

Percentages are based on employed respondents who said their main job was very related or somewhat related to their program.

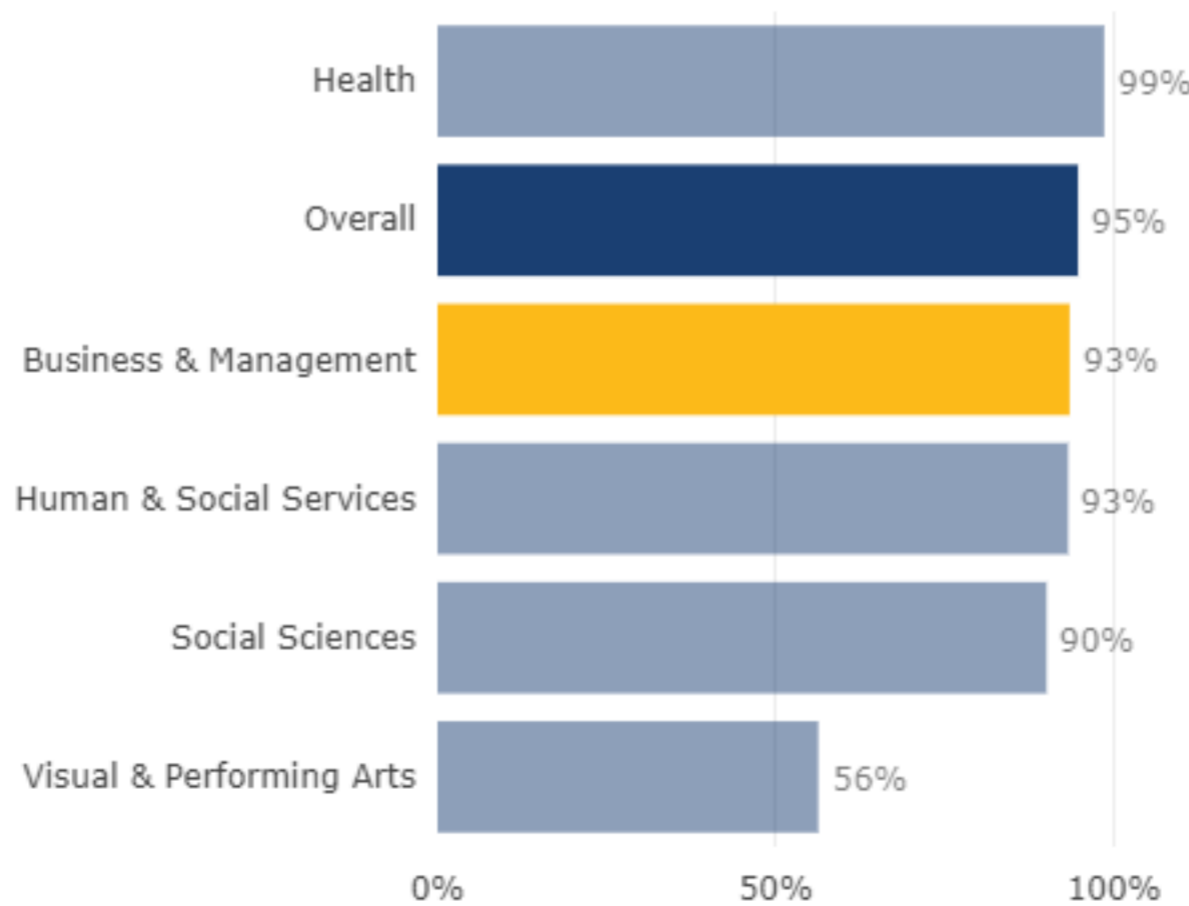

Percentages are based on employed respondents who said the knowledge and skills they gained were very useful or somewhat useful in performing their job.

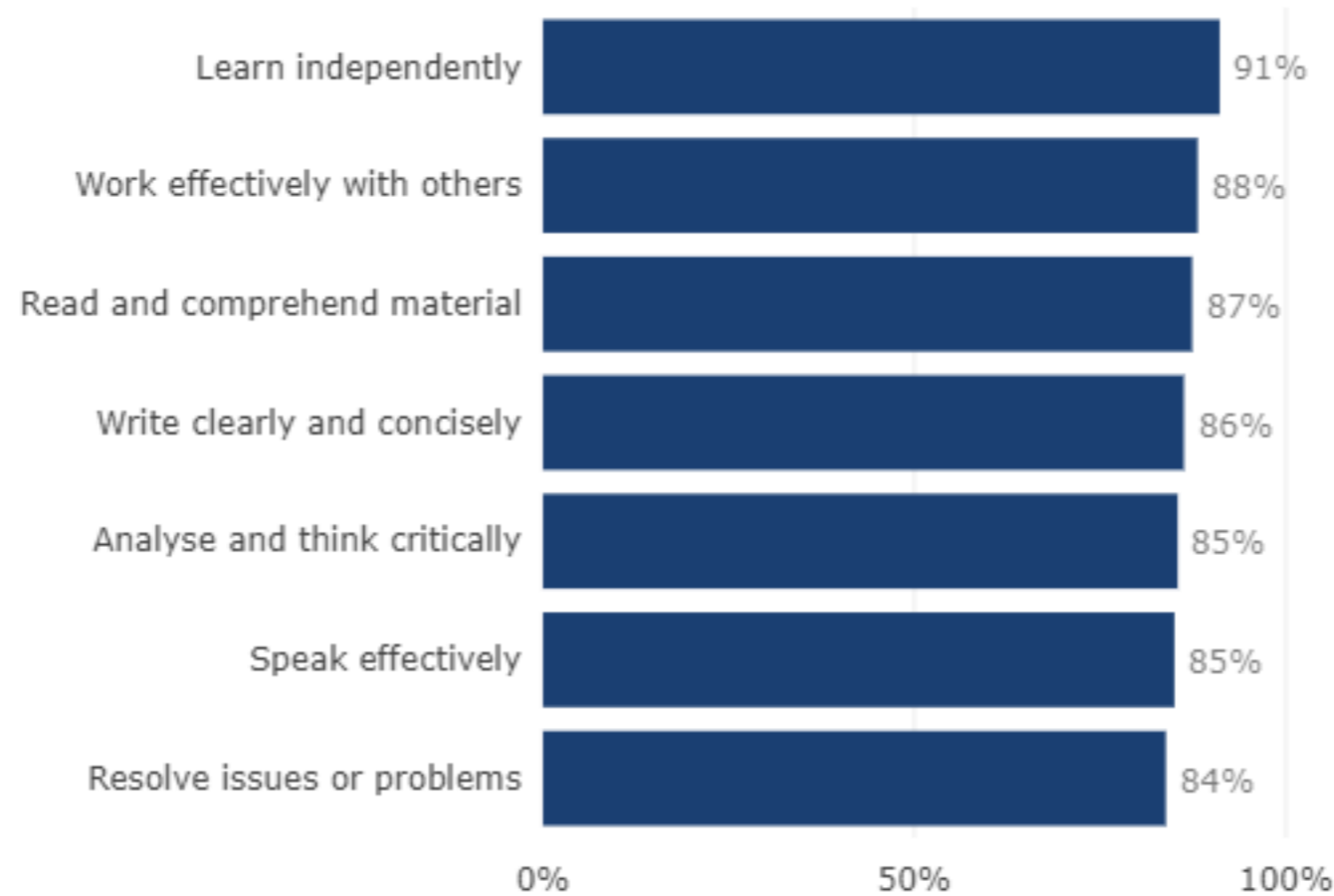

Former students were asked how helpful their program was in their development of a number of skills. Percentages are based on respondents who said their program was very helpful or helpful in developing the skill.

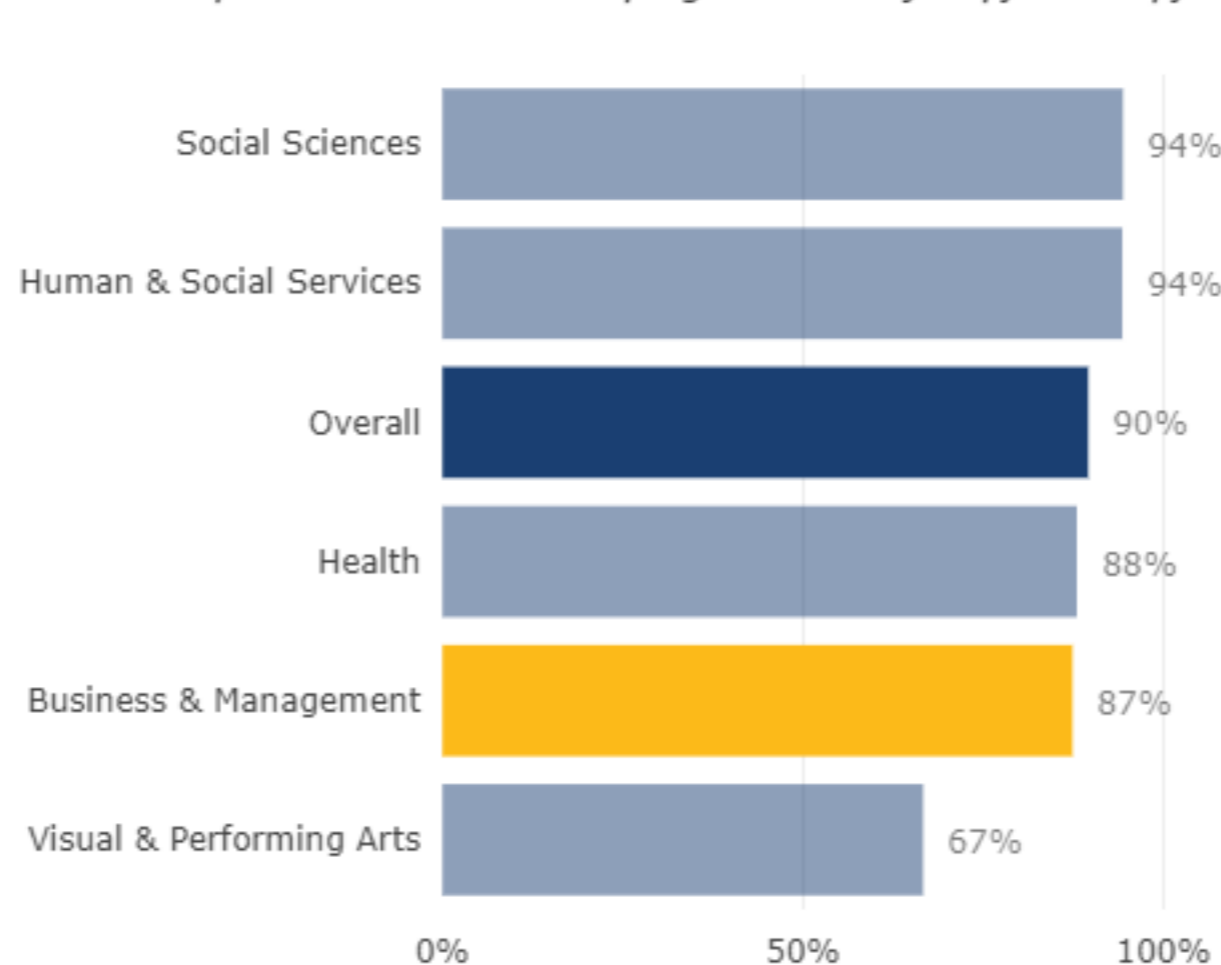

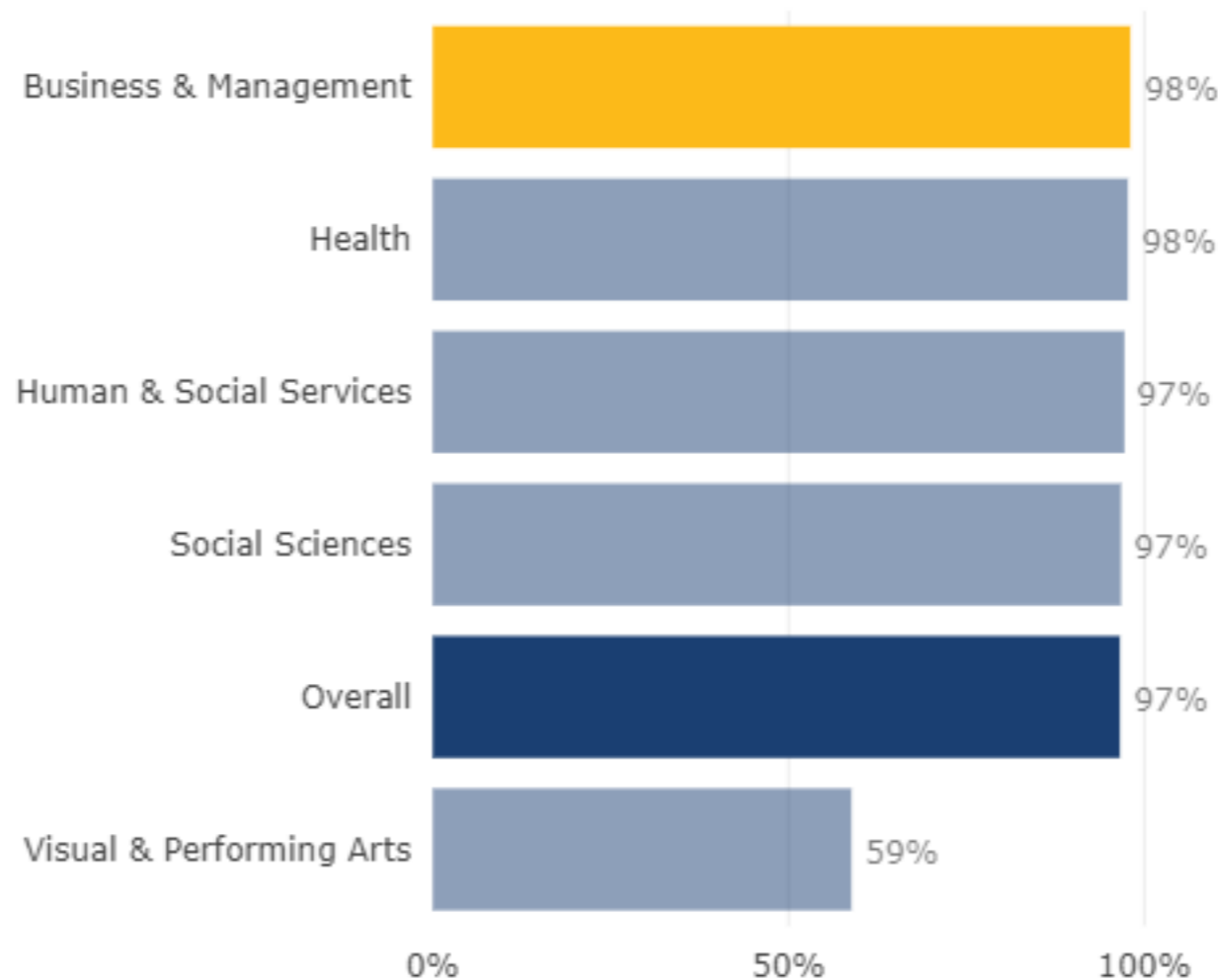
