HOW DO I APPLY FOR PSYCHOLOGY HONOURS?

Please come in to see the BA Applied Psychology coordinator as early as you can in your degree to help with course planning.

Application Process:

NOTE: Typically, students will already be in the BA Applied Psychology program, but on rare occasions they are not. **We NO LONGER recommend that students wait to take PSYC 3301** (required for honours) in the Winter semester of their **Honours year.**

- 1. Check that you meet the entrance requirements for the Honours: minimum 75 credit hours completed and program GPA = 3.33 at time of application.
- 2. Obtain a copy of the Honours application form from the Psychology Blackboard Communication Page (under BA Applied Psychology Honours).
- 3. Meet with at least 2-3 Psychology faculty members who may be willing to supervise your thesis. They will not be able to confirm they will supervise you as these decisions will be made after April 1, when students are approved at the Departmental level. Put these names in order of preference on your application.
- 4. Write your "Statement of Intent" and writing sample, include these along with a CV (academic resume) with your application form.
- 5. Submit the Honours Application form to the Psychology Department before **April 1**st via email to: danel@douglascollege.ca
- 6. If you are selected at the Departmental application phase, apply to the Honours program through <u>Education Planner B.C</u>. before the May 1st deadline.
