

Course registration and waitlist information

On the <u>Registration - Winter 2025 webpage</u>, you will find helpful details about how to search and register for your courses. Make sure to watch the video tutorials available at the bottom of the page to learn more about the registration process.

Once you have registered for your courses, you may find yourself on the waitlist for some of them. If that happens, do not worry. There is still a chance you will make it into the course. When you are on the waitlist, be sure to check your <u>myAccount</u> every day because if you are given an offer, you only have **23 hours** to accept it. If you miss your

offer, you will be removed from the waitlist. If you are still on a waitlist on the first day of class, make sure you attend the class as there is still a chance you will get in. Visit the <u>Waitlist Information webpage</u> for more information.



Fee payment and financial aid

Get to know the <u>Dates & Deadlines webpage</u> to make sure you are on top of everything. The fee payment deadline is **December 9**. If you do not pay your fees on time, you will be deregistered from your courses and removed from any waitlists. Make sure this does not happen to you! Details on ways to pay can be found on the <u>Paying</u> <u>Your Fees webpage</u>.

First semester students can contact Enrolment Services advisors for financial aid support. They can assist you with applying for loans, bursaries and scholarships. If you are a B.C. resident and plan on applying for B.C. student loans, check your <u>StudentAid</u> <u>BC eligibility</u> and, if necessary, get the required information from your parent/guardian to apply. For questions about loans or other financial aid matters, <u>contact Enrolment</u> <u>Services</u>.
